scene safety

Scene safe is a term that EMT and EMS responders use to get a feel for their environmental safety, before they enter a situation. The reason this term is used is because it is simple to remember. When you think about it, there are rarely two smaller words used that can have as much meaning. "Scene Safety" means that you have to be aware of the safety issues, correct them and "do the right thing", by holding your teammate accountable. How does this apply to Aurora? The more we hold ourselves and others accountable for safety, the more we benefit. Benefits may be seen fiscally through raises or bonuses, or by a healthier, safer work environment. Believe it or not, we have more control over costs to our company than we give ourselves credit for. We can play a huge part in whether or not Aurora is profitable, just by making our "Scene Safe." So while at your work site, keep these checklists in mind to help you focus on safety.
